Delhi University Admissions: A Check List for you.

[For the admission procedure June 1- June 15, 2007]

- > **Friday, 1st June, 2007:** Starting of sale and receipt of Application Forms for admission to the Colleges
- > **Friday, 15th June, 2007** [Up to 1.00p.m.]: Last date for receipt of Application Forms
- > **Tuesday, 26th June 2007:** First cut-off list (Day Colleges at 10am and Evening Colleges at 4pm)
- > **June 27th to 29th:** Admission and Payment of Fees (Up to 1pm for day colleges and 4-7pm for evening colleges)

Important Tips

- > Carry Class X Certificate
- > Carry photocopies of class XII Mark Sheet & Certificate
- > Carry lots of passport size photographs for filling forms of individual colleges.
- > Candidates seeking admission to Hostel may contact the College concerned directly.
- > St. Stephens and Jesus and Mary College do not accept common Pre-admission forms.
- > For courses with an entrance test, or for admissions through the sports and ECA quotas, fill in the individual college forms.

For pre-admission forms:

- > The form costs Rs.30
- > The subject codes to be filled in the form are different from the ones allotted by the CBSE. Use the information sheet (Table A) provided with the pre-admission Form to darken the circles.
- > The 'W' in the parentheses after the name of the college stands for women's college.
- > Be careful while circling your options; use the sample form if necessary.
- > The pre-admission Form has two sides. After filling both sides, take photocopy of form on single page i.e. both sides, submit to any of the 17 centers and get it duly stamped on photocopy as acknowledgement.
- > Do not crumple, fold or mutilate the form in order to avoid rejection.
- > Use only black or blue pen. Darken the circles completely.
- > The black margins on the side should not be tampered with.
- > Do carry a bottle of water. Be patient and contact volunteers/counsellors in case of problems.
